Warmer	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher shows videos or pictures of popular Korean celebrities. 2. Teacher asks students <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. if they have watched Korean shows or if they have the heard of them b. what makes Korean celebrities so popular 3. Teacher writes the title on the board and briefly discusses. 	3 mins
Pre-reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher asks students to look at the pictures and title on page 33. 2. Teachers arranges students into small groups and distributes Task 1 [KWL chart]. 3. Teacher asks students to fill in the first and second columns in Task 1. 	5 mins
While-Reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher asks students to read the text. 2. While reading, students have to check their reading with the first and second columns in Task 1. 	8 mins

Post Reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher asks students to complete the third column in Task 1. Students could also add any interesting facts they have found in the text 2. Teacher discusses the information the students have recorded in Task 1. 3. Teacher distributes Task 2. 4. In pairs, students answer the questions in Task 2. 5. Teacher discusses the answers. 	18 mins
Wrap	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher asks students to complete the reading comprehension on page 37. 	5 mins
