| Pre-reading | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher gets students to look at page 27 and goes through the glossary. | 5 mins |
| While-Reading | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher distributes Task 1. 2. Teacher gets students to read the text from page 24 – 25. 3. Students read and fill in the chart in Task 1. | 10 mins |
| Post-reading | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher checks the answers to Task 1 and provide feedback. 2. Teacher distributes Task 2. 3. In pairs students complete the task. 4.
