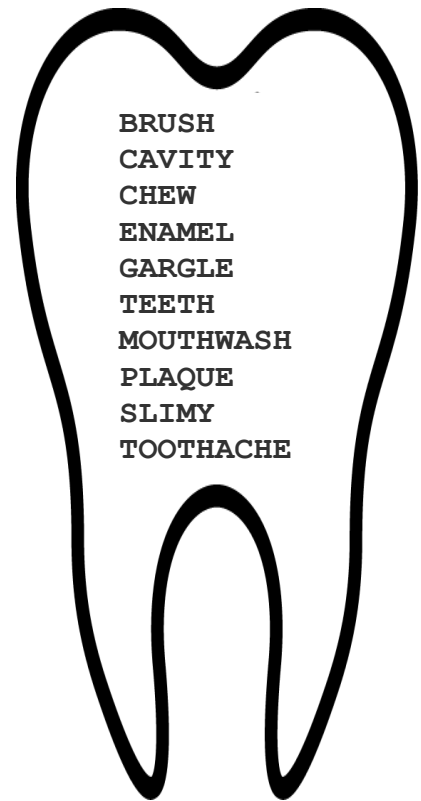
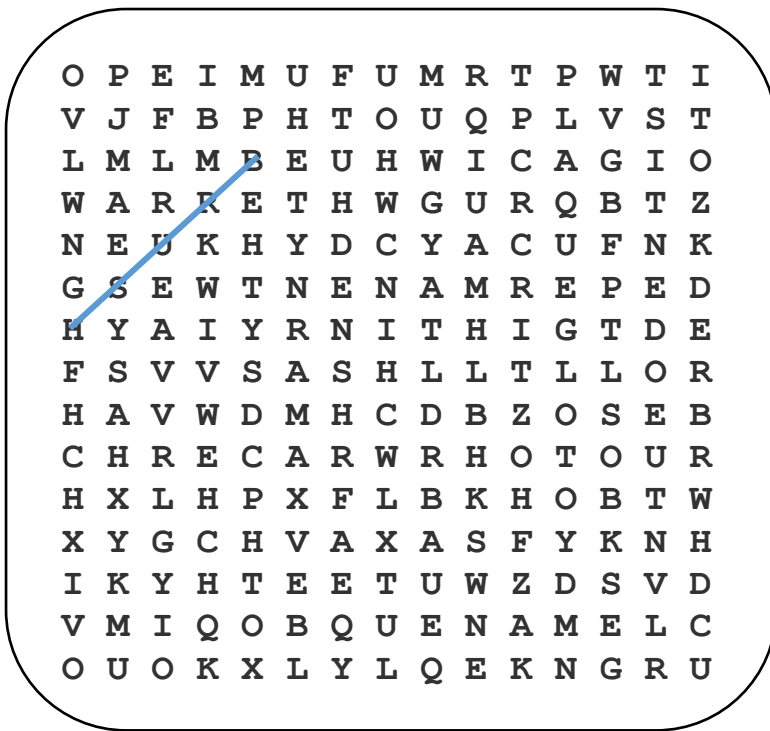




Stages	Procedure	Time
<b>Objectives</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To practice               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. scanning skills</li> <li>b. guessing the meaning in context</li> </ol> </li> </ol>	
<b>Warmer</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Ask students:-               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. How many times do you brush your teeth every day?</li> <li>ii. What do you call a baby's first set of teeth? (Ans: milk teeth)</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Elicit some answers from the students.</li> </ol>	<b>3 mins</b>
<b>Pre-reading</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tell students to turn to page 9 and read the title and ask students to guess the topic of the article.</li> <li>2. Teacher writes students' predictions on the board.</li> <li>3. Asks students to do worksheet <b>Task 1</b>(word search).</li> <li>4. Check with partner.</li> <li>5. Explain some of the vocabulary words with the students.</li> </ol>	<b>10 mins</b>
<b>While-Reading</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Ask students to read page 9 to 13.</li> <li>2. While reading, students complete <b>Task 2</b>.</li> </ol>	<b>12 mins</b>
<b>Post-reading</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Teacher elicits answers to Task 2.</li> <li>2. Teacher assigns <b>Task 3</b> and students are required to complete it in pairs.</li> <li>3. Teacher elicits answers from students.</li> <li>4. Teacher assigns <b>Task 4</b>.</li> </ol>	<b>10 mins</b>
<b>Wrap</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teacher recaps the lesson by asking students to close their JEM and give other ideas of how to take care of their teeth (eg. eating habits, supplements).</li> </ul>	<b>5 mins</b>
