Stages	Procedure	Time
Objectives	 To practice guessing meaning of words in context skimming and scanning for details paraphrasing sentences 	
Warmer	 Teacher can put on something trendy for this lesson. Teachers then shows student picture of an expensive haute couture (e.g. Kate Middleton's custom made wedding dress). Teacher explains the meaning of 'haute couture' and asks students to guess for its price. (<i>Answer: \$415,000</i>). Teacher elicits guesses. 	5 mins
Pre-reading	 Teacher writes the following on the board: a) America's Next Top Model b) Project Runway c) Say Yes to The Dress d) How Do I Look? With the magazine close, teacher asks students if they know any of the TV shows written on the board. Teacher elicits for responses. Next, teacher asks students to guess what the article is going to be about. 	5 mins
While-Reading	 Teacher puts students into small groups and distributes Task 1. Teacher gets students to answer vocabulary questions without using the dictionary. Teacher elicits and confirms answers. Teacher gets students to continue with Task 2. Teacher elicits and confirms answers. 	15 mins
Post-reading	 Next, teacher distributes Task 3. Teacher elicits answers for the last paraphrasing question. Teacher discusses and confirms answers. 	10 mins
Wrap	 Before teacher wraps up lesson, teacher can ask students the following questions about his/her own outfit: a) Is this trendy? b) How much do you think it costs? 	5 mins
