Warmer	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teachers gets students to look at the picture on page 28. 2. Teachers asks students if they know the difference between a scooter and a motorcycle. Scooter – smaller wheels, feet placed on flat surface, front legs shielded, not suitable for hilly terrain, not suitable for highways. 	5 mins
Pre-reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher goes through the words in the Glossary on page 28. 	5 mins
While-Reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher gets students to read the article. 2. While reading, students are to find out if Alice bought the scooter. (Answer: No. The town people bought it for her) 	10 mins
Post-reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher checks the answer to the while reading question and provide feedback. 2. Teacher distributes Task 1. 3. In pairs, students complete the exercise. 4. Teacher discusses the answers. 5. Teacher assigns Task 2. Students complete it. 6. Teacher discusses answers. 	10 mins
