Objectives	<ol> <li>To practice         <ul> <li>a. scanning skills</li> <li>b. guessing the meaning in context</li> </ul> </li> </ol>	
Warmer	<ol> <li>Teacher writes the word 'idioms' on the board &amp; asks         <ol> <li>Do you know what this word means?</li> <li>Can you give me an example of an idiom?</li> </ol> </li> <li>Teacher elicit response to the questions, give one or two         examples if none are forthcoming from the students.</li> <li>Teacher leads into the topic of the day.</li> </ol>	4 mins
Pre-reading	<ol> <li>Teacher arranges the students into small groups.</li> <li>Teacher distributes Task 1</li> <li>In small groups, students work on Task 1.</li> <li>Teacher checks answer. (Students may not know most of these idioms but the idea here is to let them guess at the meanings.)</li> </ol>	10 mins
While-Reading	<ol> <li>Teacher distributes Task 2.</li> <li>Students answer the questions in Task 2.</li> </ol>	8 mins
Post-reading	<ol> <li>Teacher checks the answers and provide feedback.</li> <li>Teacher distributes <b>Task 3</b>.</li> <li>In small groups, students discuss and match each situation to its corresponding idiom.</li> <li>Teacher discusses the answers.</li> </ol>	10 mins
Wrap	1. Teacher does a concept check of the lesson	5 mins
