STARTER

Objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To practice <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. skimming and scanning skills b. prediction skill c. guessing meanings of words in context 	
Warmer	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher asks students to recap what happened in Part 1 of the story. 2. Teacher now asks students to predict what events will take place in Part 2 by ticking off sentences in the given list (see appendix). 	10 mins
Pre-reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher arranges the students into small groups. 2. Teacher distributes Task 1 – to predict what events will take place in Part 2 by ticking off sentences in the given list. 3. In small groups, students discuss Task 1. 4. Teacher elicits for students' responses. 	10 mins
While-Reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Class checks their responses to Task 1 with the cover story. 2. Teacher distributes Task 2. 3. Students answer the questions in Task 2. 	10 mins
Post-reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher checks the answers and provide feedback. 2. Teacher distributes Task 3. 3. In pairs, students complete the task. 4. Teacher discusses the answers. 	10 mins
Wrap	Teacher does a concept check of the lesson	2 mins

TASK 1

You read Part 1 of The adventures of Salvator Rosa in the last issue of the magazine. Can you predict what happened after? Tick (✓) the sentences that you think will describe what happens in Part 2 of the story.
