SURVIVING HIGH SCHOOL – NOW WHAT?

Stages	Procedure	Time
Objectives	<ol> <li>To practice</li> <li>a. guessing meaning of words in context</li> <li>b. scanning</li> <li>c. inferencing</li> </ol>	
Warmer	<ol> <li>Teacher shows a picture of a boat.</li> <li>a. Have you sailed in a boat before?</li> <li>b. What will you do if you get lost at sea?</li> <li>c. What do you call a common tool to find your way?</li> <li>Teacher leads into the topic of the day.</li> </ol>	2 mins
Pre-reading	<ol> <li>Teacher arranges the students in pairs.</li> <li>Teacher distributes <b>Task 1</b></li> <li>In small groups, students work on <b>Task 1</b>. (matching phrases)</li> <li>Teacher checks answer and asks students clues that help them find the answer)</li> </ol>	3 mins
While-Reading	<ol> <li>Students in groups read the article and complete Task 2-Paragraphs are divided among students to make questions (Teacher divides paragraphs depending on class size)</li> <li>Students are to do 2 WH-questions and 2 Yes/No questions for each given paragraph.</li> <li>Teacher can give examples of one or two questions.</li> <li>Teacher distributes Task 2.</li> <li>Students create questions in Task 2.</li> <li>Teacher monitors and assists students.</li> </ol>	15 mins
Post-reading	<ol> <li>Teacher conducts a competition by each group asking questions to the class.</li> <li>Teacher gives time limit for answers.</li> <li>Groups get points for each correct answer.</li> <li>Teacher distributes Task 3</li> <li>Students practice inferencing</li> <li>Teacher discusses the answers by eliciting clues that lead to their answers.</li> </ol>	20 mins
