Pre-reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher arranges the students into pairs. 2. Teacher distributes Task 1. 3. In pairs, students discuss and complete Task 1. 4. Teacher checks answer. 	6 mins
While-Reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher distributes Task 2. 2. Teacher asks students to use scanning skills to circle keywords in the Wh-questions. 3. In pairs, students discuss and complete Task 2. 4. Teacher checks answer. 	15 mins
Post-reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher distributes Task 3. 2. Teacher asks students to use scanning skills to sequence the Green Man's life events. 3. In pairs, students discuss and complete Task 3. 4. Teacher checks answer. 	10 mins
Wrap	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher does a concept check on "urban legend". Teacher asks students, "What urban legends do you know, and do you believe in them?" 	5 mins
