Stages	Procedure	Time
Objectives	<ol> <li>To practice</li> <li>a. guessing the meaning of words through synonyms</li> <li>b. scanning skills</li> </ol>	
Warmer/ Lead-in	<ol> <li>Teacher asks students         <ul> <li>a. What would you like to get paid for?</li> <li>b. If you are an adult now, what kind of work would you do?</li> </ul> </li> <li>Teacher leads into the topic of the day.</li> <li>Based on the student's answer, teacher quickly arranges students according to job or interest groups.</li> </ol>	5 mins
Pre-reading	<ol> <li>Teacher distributes <b>Task 1</b>.</li> <li>In small groups, students discuss and complete <b>Task 1</b>.</li> <li>Teacher checks answer.</li> </ol>	12 mins
While-reading	<ol> <li>Teacher distributes Task 2.</li> <li>In groups, students complete Task 2.</li> <li>Teacher checks answer and provides feedback.</li> </ol>	8 mins
Post-reading	<ol> <li>Teacher distributes Task 3.</li> <li>Teacher asks students to refer to a diagram on page 33.</li> <li>Students discuss and complete Task 3 in groups.</li> <li>Teacher discusses the answers by asking students to view the diagram again.</li> </ol>	10 mins
Wrap	<ol> <li>Teacher does a concept check of the lesson by asking, "Would you like to find your ikigai?"</li> </ol>	5 mins
