## Learning Activity

Name the Three R's of the environment. What do they mean?

1. **Reduce** – reduce waste, throw less, reduce pollution (e.g. walk more instead of riding cars), buy less, use less (save water and energy – turn off the tap when brushing your teeth; switch off the lights when not using)
2. **Reuse** – bring your own bag to do grocery shopping, bring your Tupperware when buying food from the food court, donate clothes and toys instead of throwing, have a garage sale to reduce your load, reuse jars and containers wherever space permits
3. **Recycle** – create new things with existing things e.g. make a pencil holder using a soda can; buy products that contain recycled materials e.g. paper towels & garbage bags; use recycle bins to sort your items for recycling (glass, paper, metal, plastic)
